DENTAL SCHOOLS PREREQUISITE COURSES TIME LINE

This time line presents the pre-dental course requirements for Texas and most out-of-state U.S. dental schools. Six semesters, regardless of the student's age or year in college, are generally required to complete the pre-dental courses and extra-curricular activities.

Consult your academic advisor for help incorporating these courses into your degree plan and for selecting options based on your degree requirements. Check the Course Schedule for prerequisites for these courses.

5 – YEAR PLAN including BRIDGE YEAR

Many students spread their dental school prerequisites over 3-1/2 to 4 years and use the additional time as an opportunity to become more competitive and better prepared.
