The HPO has submitted descriptions and syllabi of these courses to the school for their review. Students are responsible for comparing the syllabi of your courses to the requirements as described on the TCU website linked above. Required coursework must be completed with a letter grade of C or higher. C- is not accepted for prerequisites. TCU considers Credit-by-Exam (such as AP, IB, CLEP) for prerequisites on a case-by-case basis. **Biochemistry** BCH 369 or BCH 339F Lab is not required. (1 course) Genetics **BIO 325** Lab is not required. (1 course) Physiology **BIO 365S** Lab is not required.
