

PHARMACY PREREQUISITE COURSES TIME LINE

This is an **example** of how to complete the pre-pharmacy course requirements for the Texas pharmacy schools.

Some Texas schools and out-of-state pharmacy schools require the courses listed in Semesters 5 and 6, and these courses are highly recommended to be well-prepared for any PharmD program.
