

## OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY PREREQUISITE COURSES TIME LINE

This is an **example** of how to complete prerequisite courses for the **Texas Occupational Therapy programs**.

Six semesters, regardless of the student's age or year in college, are generally required to complete the preoccupational therapy courses and extra-curricular activities.

Many students **finish prerequisites in Year 4 or later** and have a **bridge year or years** during which they continue to prepare for and apply to professional schools.
