Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD) Programs

The OTD prepares students for advanced roles in practice leadership, patient advocacy, and faculty positions. Entry-Level OTD Programs are for those seeking their initial Occupational Therapy Degree and License.

Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT) and Master of Science in Occupational Therapy (MSOT) Programs

MSOT programs generally include some research in their curriculum.

Currently, MOT/MSOT and OTD/DOT graduates are qualified for the same OT license.

***Students who graduate from a program accredited by the accreditation standards of ACOTE will be eligible to work as an occupational therapist whether they have a doctoral degree or a master's degree. If AOTA reaches the decision to move to a single point of entry and mandates that point of entry to be a doctoral degree, the OTs with their master's degree will be grandfathered in and will not require any additional education.
