

PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT PROGRAMS PREREQUISITE COURSES TIMELINE

This **example timeline** includes the pre-PA course requirements for Texas and most U. S. medical schools. *Please see our website for course numbers.*

Some schools require the completion of all prerequisite courses and hours of experience by the application deadline. Many PA programs require the completion of your prerequisite coursework to be completed IN PERSON, not online.

If starting in Freshman Year, you can prepare to apply after Junior Year and start PA school after graduation.

Your personal timeline may differ from this sample.

Work with your academic advisor to incorporate these courses into your personal degree plan.

INDIVIDUAL SCHOOLS MAY REQUIRE OR RECOMMEND ADDITIONAL COURSES NOT INCLUDED HERE.

Review individual school websites and the HPO's online prerequisite courses list to ensure proper courses are being taken.

***Because the Pre-PA pathway is heavier in BIO/MBS/INB coursework, it is recommended that you take Intro Biology I as soon as possible to stay on track. Principles of Chemistry is flexible since usually only one semester of O Chem is required for most programs. ***
